

# What is a Digi Rack Box?

The Pinanson **Digi Rack Box** is an interface where **all the audio signals from the stage** converge to the Stage box of a digital console. It provides **Remote boxes connection, Patching, Analogue splitter and Protection for the Digital Stage Box.**

**a** The stage microphones and instruments are connected to **remote boxes** and these are connected to the Remote boxes **input module** of our Digi Rack Box through audio multicores.

**a1** With the Remote boxes **patching module** each input is assigned a digital stage box channel through a patch.

**b** The **Direct input patch module** collects the inputs directly on XLR or the inputs coming from the previous module.

**c** The **Analogue output module** allows an extra analogue output via Multi.

**d** The **Digital Stage Box connection module** is the union between our Digi Rack Box and the Digital Stage Box.
